



JANUARY 21st KCA MEETING GUEST IS NEW 3RD DISTRICT COMMANDER JACOB KISHTER --PARKING BILL DISCUSSION --

In December 2009 Chief Lanier named then-Inspector Jacob Kishter to be the Acting Commander of MPD's 3rd District, which closely mirrors the political boundaries of Ward One. Nearing 20 years with the Department, Commander Kishter was Inspector at the 3rd District substation and has commanded the Forensic Science Services Division and the Internal Affairs Division. From 2001 to 2007, he served in the Department's Office of Professional Responsibility, where he rose to the rank of Captain. He holds a Bachelor's and Master's Degree in Management from Johns Hopkins University.

Also on the agenda will be discussion of a Ward One parking bill that has the following elements:

1. All residents would be eligible for the Residential Parking Program (RPP);
2. All households in Ward One would be eligible for a Visitor's pass, for which a fee could be charged, and which could have limited hours;
3. RPP streets (zoned residential) would have one side of the block reserved for Ward One RPP participants, and Visitor pass holders from the pass owner's ANC. The other side of these RPP streets would remain as they currently are with a 2 hour window for visitors;
4. A fee structure is established for RPP stickers per household: 15.00 for the 1st, 50.00 for the 2nd, 100.00 for the 3rd sticker.

Also, Vicky Beasley, the Mayor's nominee for the position of People's Counsel has asked for time to introduce herself and say a few words about her nomination and the role of the People's Counsel.
